Intermediate Fly-Fishing Weekend

September 25, 26, 27, 2009

This Beyond BOW event is for individuals with some fly-fishing experience. The goal of this course is to help attendees move towards their independence as fly-anglers. Some of the topics that will be covered throughout the weekend are: the finer points of casting – accuracy, timing, shooting the line; reading the water and then picking a proper fly and knowing how to cast it; what to do when you catch a fish – playing and releasing; and ethics. Participants will have the opportunity to fish both still and moving water. Attendees must supply their own rod and reel.

This is a rain or shine weekend, please come prepared for all types of weather. A fishing license is not required during scheduled class time. However, if you plan to fish outside of class you will need to purchase a license. Licenses can be purchased online at www.FishNH.com or in person at any Fish and Game license agent.

This event will be held at Purity Spring Resort in Madison, NH. You will be staying in the Osceola Lodge, which offers spacious rooms with 3-4 persons per room. Linens will be provided. All rooms have showers or baths and flush toilets. Meals will be served buffet-style in the Purity Spring dining hall and bag lunches will be provided both days.

The cost of the event is \$275 which includes all meals, lodging, instruction and materials.

Intermediate Fly Fishing Important Registration Information

CONFIRMATION: Upon being registered, you will be sent a written confirmation that you have been accepted to the program, along with an information packet. If the program is full, your name will be put on a waiting list until August 28, 2009. If no space becomes available, your check will be returned or your credit card refunded at that time.

CANCELLATION DEADLINE: If you cancel by August 28, 2009, you will receive a full refund. **Registrants who do not cancel by August 28, 2009, will be assessed the full program fee.** If you cannot attend, you may send a substitute in your place. Please advise us by September 7.

REGISTRATION: Registered participants must check-in on Friday, September 25, between 7 pm and 8 pm. After you park your vehicle in your assigned parking spot (where it will stay for the entire weekend), and settle into your room, you are invited to enjoy a wine and cheese reception.

LODGING/MEALS: The Osceola Lodge at Purity Spring Resort offers spacious rooms with 3-4 persons per room. Linens will be provided. All rooms have showers or baths and flush toilets. EQUIPMENT: Participants must supply their own rod and reel. Waders and **polarized** sunglasses are a plus but not required.

FISHING LICENSE: A fishing license is not required during scheduled class time. However, if you plan to fish outside of class time you will need to purchase a license. Licenses can be purchased online at www.FishNH.com or in person at any Fish and Game license agent.

BOW MERCHANDISE: Long and short-sleeve t-shirts, embroidered fleece vests, pullovers and caps will be available for purchase throughout the weekend.

Participants are advised that photographs and/or filming may occur during the sessions and may be used in future support of the program.

DIRECTIONS TO PURITY SPRING RESORT:

From Boston, MA: (2 ½ hours)

I-95 North to Portsmouth, NH. White Mountain Exit to Spaulding Turnpike (becomes Route 16). Route 16 North to Center Ossipee, take Route 25 East (5 miles), to Route 153 North (6 miles).

From Manchester, NH: (1 ¾ hours)

Route 28 North to Route 16 North, then Route 25 East (5 miles), to Route 153 North (6 miles).

From Portland, ME: (1 hour)

Route 25 West to Effingham, NH then take Route 153 North (6 miles).

FALL BOW WEEKEND is held annually, the weekend after Labor Day, at Rockywold/Deephaven Camps on Squam Lake in Holderness.

WINTER BOW is a one-day event, held in February at the Owl Brook Hunter Education Center in Holderness.
