IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

REGISTRATION IS ONLINE ONLY: Registration opens **May 6, 2019**. Go to nhbow.com, where you will be directed to the event registration page. Payment and accompanying forms must be at Fish and Game headquarters by **May 27, 2019**. If the program is full, check back often to see if spaces have opened up through cancellations.

REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION: Upon being registered, you will be sent an email confirmation. Once your payment is received, you will be sent an information package (directions to Coleman State Park, an itinerary, and a list of what to bring). If we do not receive your payment by **May 27, 2019**, your name will be **REMOVED** from the roster.

CANCELLATION POLICY: If you cancel by **June 7, 2019**, you will receive a full refund. **Registrants who do not attend and who do not cancel by this date will be assessed the full program fee.** You may send a substitute in your place; please advise us if you choose to do this by **June 7, 2019** by calling Kaitlyn Kelleher at (603) 271-0495.

CHECK-IN TIME: Please arrive by **6:30 p.m.** on Friday, **June 21st** to check in.

CLOTHING: This workshop will be held outdoors for most of the weekend, so please plan accordingly. **Participants MUST bring waterproof clothing and sturdy footwear suitable for outdoor activities.** A list of recommended clothing and supplies to bring will be sent with your registration confirmation. **Participants are required to bring their own fly rod and reel.** Please bring your own waders if you have them; there will be some available to borrow.

FEE: \$270. Includes instruction, program materials, use of some demonstration equipment, 5 meals and 2 nights lodging. **PLEASE MAIL THE PAYMENT FORM AND FEE** after registering online. Registration opens on **May 6, 2019**.

LOCATION: Coleman Lodges is located at Coleman State Park, 1166 Diamond Pond Road, Stewartstown, NH. Coleman State Park lies on the shore of Little Diamond Pond, 12 miles east of Colebrook, in New Hampshire's North Country.
